ENTRANCE

Harvey Dunn and Anne Sullivan Elementary:

Parents should enter through the main front doors and then through the community center. The Boys & Girls Club program is held in the community center space.

Eugene Field, Laura B. Anderson, Rosa Parks and Susan B. Anthony Elementary:

Parents should enter through the main front door. The Boys & Girls Club program is held in Multi-Purpose Room, right at the entrance.

CHECK IN/CHECK OUT:

- Parents/guardians should check out their child(ren) using ProCare with the iPad found on the cart near the program's entrance.
- All children need to be signed out by a parent/guardian or other authorized person listed on your enrollment form. You must walk into the building to pick your child up from the program.
- Please make sure anyone picking up your child(ren) has been listed as an emergency contact/authorized pick-up person and is prepared to show identification (including parents/guardians)

PAYMENTS

- A method of payment is acquired during the enrollment process and used to process the programs registration fee.
- Tuition is collected through an EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer) from the parent/guardian account to Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sioux Empire through Tuition Express.
- The method of payment provided will be charged automatically every Tuesday for the current week's tuition.
- If Tuesday is a bank holiday tuition charges will be processed the next business day.
- A \$15.00 return fee will be added to accounts on all payment declines or returned payments.
- Payment methods may be updated at any time by calling our main office at (605) 338.8061.

Statements are available at <u>www.myprocare.com</u> (which is different from the ProCare app).



TERMINATION/WITHDRAWAL

Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sioux Empire requires a two-week written notice when withdrawing. Withdrawal forms can be obtained by calling our main office at (605) 338.8061. When appropriate notice is not given, the account will be charged for two weeks of service, even if the children may not be attending.

CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE

Eligible families are responsible for all co-pays and any fees that may accrue based on coverage. Any tuition fees not covered through Child Care Assistance are the parent/guardian's responsibility.

All of our programs utilize ProCare as a communication and childcare management system, which allows us to enrich program and parent interactions.


SIGN-UP

You should receive an email from ProCare (connect-hello@online.procaresoftware.com) with simple instructions on how to set up an account and get linked to your child(ren). The email will include a unique code that is tied to the information we set up for you. If you do not see the email by your child's first day, please look in your Junk folder or check with our Family Engagement Coordinators at (605) 338.8061 to ensure we have an up-to-date email address on file.



MOBILE APP

We recommend adding the ProCare app to your mobile device. Simply search "ProCare" in your App Store or Google Play Store and the free ProCare: Childcare App should be easily downloadable. The app is a convenient tool to give you quick access to your child's daily activities, and updates/communication from our staff.







PROCAL App

DAILY SIGN-IN/OUT

Early Learning Academies:

• All children need to be signed in and out by a parent/guardian or other authorized person, which can be done using the ProCare screen found near the program's entrance.

K-5 Enrichment Program:

- For After-School care, BGCSE staff will check in all students who are present that day. If a child does not arrive at our after-school K-5 program and we do not have notice of an absence, BGCSE staff work with school officials and the BGCSE office to locate the child immediately. For checking students out, Parents/guardians or other authorized persons will need to walk into the site and use ProCare with the iPad found on the welcome cart near the program's entrance.
- For Before-School care, all children need to be signed in by a parent/guardian or other authorized person using ProCare with the iPad found on the welcome cart near the program's entrance. BGCSE staff will transport or dismiss students to their schools/classrooms as appropriate to start their school day.

MESSAGING

ProCare has a two-way messaging system that allows you to communicate directly with your site/teacher. Feel free to use this channel for notices about your child's health, schedule (ie absences), activities, etc.

MEAL INFORMATION

The Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sioux Empire provides an afternoon snack and is a peanut-free facility. We do not allow additional snacks or food items to be brought in by students (unless a special diet form is on file). Please contact your K-5 Manager if you have questions and/or concerns, and look to our Family Handbook for more information on our Meals & Nutrition policy.

SCHEDULES

To comply with State licensing regulations, it is crucial that we have accurate and up-to-date schedules for all children to ensure we are appropriately staffed and to meet staff-to-child ratios. Please send any schedule updates to our website at

ABSENCES

Parents/guardians must notify BGCSE of all child absences via Procare or by contacting our Family Engagement Coordinators at (605) 338.8061. Extended absences without notification may result in termination of services.

Students are not allowed to bring toys or games from home unless BGCSE staff have permitted the items. BGCSE is not liable for the loss, damage, misuse, or theft of any personal items brought on BGCSE property.


